On April 1, 2018, **Banco de Tokyo-Mitsubishi UFJ Brasil S/A** officially changed its name to **Banco MUFG Brasil S.A.**, as part of a global initiative to unify the brands of operational units held by Mitsubishi UFJ Financial Group (MUFG).
